

Information about cookies and how they are applied

What are cookies (and similar technologies)

Cookies are unique identifiers that websites which are visited by a user transfer to the user's device – desktop computer, laptop, tablet or smartphone - to enable the systems to recognize the device at every next browsing session and to provide features.

When you browse on our website, you will be receiving cookies exclusively sent by the website and managed by our company.

A – Cookies Used by Our Website

All cookies described in this section are being transferred directly from this website and are managed by our company DOLCI COLLINE s.a.s DI LUIGI DE VICO & C. headquartered in Torino, via G. Collegno 28, Fiscal Code and VAT Number 08483700012, e-mail info@piemontehouses.com.

They are used by electronic devices for the uses that are stated for each of them. They can be disclosed to [•].

Technical cookies are used without the user's express agreement but may be disabled by the user.

In accordance with the provisions of Law 163/03, the user is entitled to receive, further to a request sent by email info@piemontehouses.com, a complete data privacy statement stating which data are being collected and how they are used, the source of the data, the logic underlying their use and moreover:

- update, amendment and correction of data;
- delete, make anonymous and block data which are gathered unlawfully.

This site does not use cookies for profiling.

B – Technical Cookies

These cookies are being used to ensure flawless browsing and to enhance the website's performance. They are not used for other purposes and are all managed by our company.

They include:

- a) browsing cookies – meant to guarantee standard browsing performance and use of a site's features. These cookies allow for example to remember search criteria, perform a purchase, sign up to an event;
- b) cookies analytics – they gather information about the number of users and how they use the website, for example which are the most frequently viewed pages or features, which are the pages from which most errors are reported. This information is gathered in aggregate and anonymous form.
- c) function cookies – they allow users to browse the site using selected criteria like for example language, typeface, web browser and are used to enhance the site's performance.

All these cookies are enabled automatically.

ASPSESSIONIDASBTDRSA (Microsoft ASP)	Technical Cookie	This cookie is used to generate sessions on (Microsoft ASP) websites based on Microsoft ASP. Having no time deadline this cookie is deleted when you close your browsing session.
